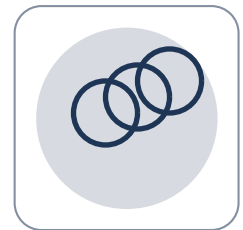
1. A Different Approach to Building

This allows the vision to extend beyond borders.



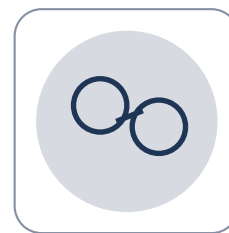
6. Strategic Partnerships

Instead, we are building in phases:

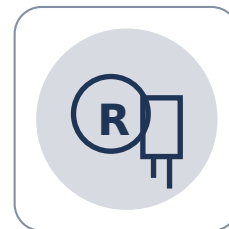
Phase 1: Early-stage funding (planning, professionals, preparation)
